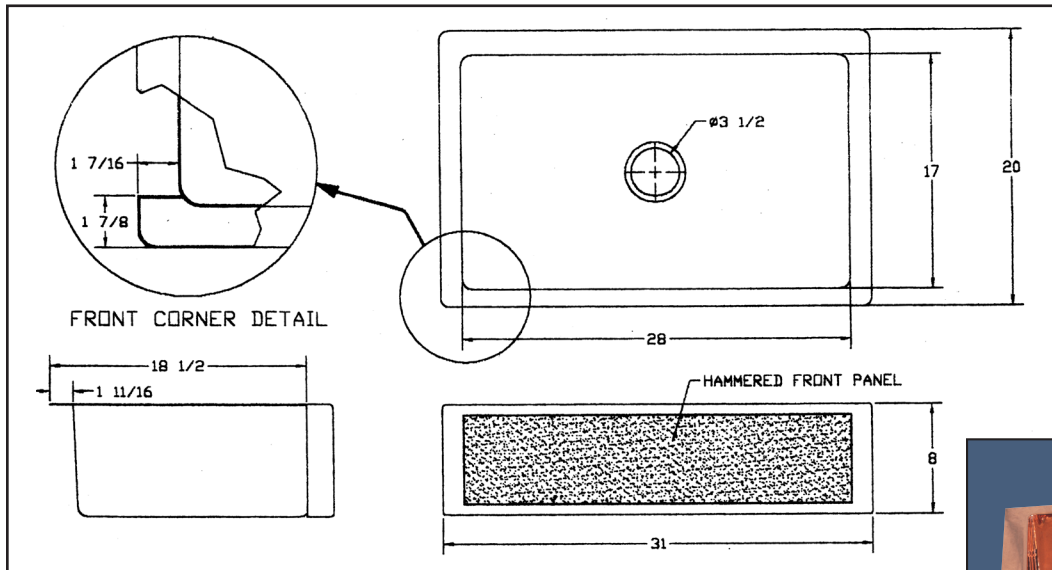

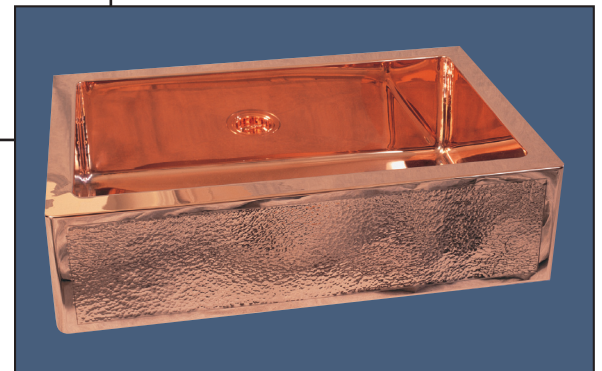

DRAIN ASSEMBLY (SPECIFY FINISH)

Kitchen Basket Strainer (3.5)
Disposal Mounting Flange (3.5)

DROP-IN INSTALLATION

1. Counter cut-out 1/4" - 3/8" larger than the inside Dimension of the basin.
2. Use provided clips to hook the brackets on the underside of the basin and sung it down.
3. Silicon calking may be used as necessary on the underside of the basin rim.

UNDER-COUNTER INSTALLATION

1. Counter cut-out to be templated using the basin itself. The client must determine the proper relationship between the basin radius and the edge of the counter cut-out.
2. The provided clip may be used to secure the basin rim to the underside of the counter-top material using one of the provided connectors or such method as might be agreed upon between the installer and the basin owner.
3. Silicon calking may be used as necessary between the upper side of the basin rim and the underside of the counter-top.
